## TREATING YOUR HAIR

<u>PREPARATION</u>: Prepare for treatment by putting a white or light-colored towel around the person's shoulders and have them sit on a stool or chair on a NON-carpeted floor.

**SPRAY:** Spray the hair starting with the scalp first. Lift up the hair and spray the roots of the hair over the entire head. (Make sure the person has a rag or towel covering their eyes.) Continue spraying until ALL the hair is dripping wet with THE LIQUID LICE COMB.

<u>WAIT</u>: Cover the head with a shower cap or towel and have the person wait. How long? It depends. If the infestation is light, 30

minutes should be enough. If the infestation is severe, you might need to wait 60 minutes – and you might need to do two treatments on that person.

RINSE: Have the person shampoo the hair in the shower. Then have them use a conditioner. While still in the shower, with the water running on the hair, brush or comb out the hair with a normal comb or brush to help any of the dead lice or loose nits get de-tangled from the hair and rinse down the drain.



## TREATING YOUR ENVIRONMENT

If you don't treat your environment, you are GUARANTEED to be fighting head lice for a LOT longer than you want to. That's because you'll get RE-INFESTATIONS from your own house.

You'll probably have to deal with Re-Infestations anyway, but treating your environment will cut down on the problem as much as possible.
